Fortbrand Services, Inc., the exclusive North American distributor for the Hagie GST 20, multi-function, multi-season airfield maintenance unit, announces that the Metropolitan Airports Commission has ordered its second Hagie GST 20 airport sprayer, equipped with a Vammas PS4200 Edge Light Plow, for use at Minneapolis-St. Paul International Airport (MSP).

The Hagie GST 20 is a unique multi-function, multi-seasonal unit that was developed for airport use in cooperation with the staff of Minneapolis-St. Paul International Airport. Currently the equipment is in use at ANC, BOS, DTW, JFK, MKE, MLI, MSP, RME, RNO and YYC. The unit can be used as (i) a high-speed, precision runway deicer and pesticide/herbicide applicator, saving both time and money in spraying applications; (ii) a runway/taxiway light plow and sign cleaner, saving airport operators hundreds of thousands of dollars in performing these tasks, as compared with traditional labor intensive methods; (iii) a flail mower and (iv) a paint and rubber removal vehicle, with the introduction of the newest attachment for the Hagie GST 20 platform - the FBS-100 High Pressure Water Paint Removal and Reclamation System. The FBS-100 unit incorporates the use of up to 40,000 psi of water pressure and a simple vacuum and storage system to meet all pavement marking removal and eradication needs. The combination of these attachments makes the Hagie GST 20 one of the only pieces of airfield maintenance equipment that can be used every day of the year.
